WHAT

This scholarship is funded by the Hunter New England and Central Coast Primary Health Network (HNECCPHN). Pending interest, TAFE NSW will run a CHC43215 Certificate IV in Alcohol and Other Drugs (AOD) and CHC43315 Mental Health in succession from Term 2 2021. Commencing with AOD.
