QR Code Check-in	Most COVID-19 restrictions are easing for all people in NSW. Please refer HERE for more information.  As General Practice is a premise for high-risk contact, the PHN recommends continued use of QR code check-in for staff and patient surveillance and safety.
PPE	As a <b>potential high risk contact premise</b> , the PHN recommends continued use of PPE, including the wearing of eye protection and physical distancing in General Practice settings.
