## COVID-19 Update for General Practice | JULY 2021 A QUICK GUIDE TO ASSIST YOUR PRACTICE STAFF

Second AstraZeneca COVID-19 Vaccine	The Australian Technical Advisory Group on Immunisation (ATAGI) has released a statement clarifying the dosage intervals for AstraZeneca in the context of a COVID-19 outbreak. The advice clarifies that in an outbreak setting, an interval of 4-8 weeks if preferred. This information was outlined in the provider bulletin sent to your practice on the 13 <sup>th</sup> July 2021.
Consent forms for COVID-19 vaccinations	Consent forms for the COVID-19 vaccination are available here.
Pfizer EOI Process	The <u>General Practice Pfizer Vaccine EOI</u> is intended to identify General Practices which are interested in administering the Pfizer vaccine. GPs <b>must</b> already be participating in the COVID-19 Vaccination Program and have the capacity to administer both the Pfizer and AstraZeneca COVID-19 vaccines as outlined <u>here</u> .
Recommendations to receive the Pfizer Vaccine (form/email)	This <b>Request for Alternative Vaccine</b> handout can be given to patients requesting the Pfizer vaccine as an alternative to AstraZeneca. The handout provides sound advice about current guidelines and requesting recommendations/rules. The <i>Request for Alternative Vaccine Form</i> is available via <u>Hunter New England (HNE)</u> and Central Coast HealthPathways ( <u>GP instructions</u> , <u>recommendation to receive</u> <u>alternative vaccine form</u> and <u>patient information sheet and vaccine form</u> ).

PRODA Access to Australian Immunisation Register (AIR)	Please remember to check AIR <b>prior to giving any vaccinations</b> , to ensure that the patient has not received the COVID-19 vaccine in the previous week. Familiarise yourself with the <u>ATAGI clinical guidelines</u> . Only a Medical Practitioner, Midwife or Nurse Practitioner with a Medicare <b>provider number</b> can access the AIR via their PRODA account. Nurses, managers and or administration require <b>delegation</b> access to the AIR.
