To request an alternative vaccine, follow the below CCLHD and NSW Health processes:

- Recommendation to Receive the Pfizer (Comirnaty) COVID-19 Vaccined [form]

- - clinical advice and support about vaccination of patients with complex or unusual medical backgrounds.
 - investigation or management advice when patients have had an adverse event following immunisation.
- Contact the Public Health Unit:
 - for advice about specific vaccination or patient concerns.
 - to discuss infection control risk.
- For advice about cold chain breaches, phone the National Vaccine Operation Centre (VOC) d on 1800-318-208.
- For adverse event reporting:
 - See NSW Health Reporting Requirements for report a serious or unexpected adverse event to vaccination.
 - Contact the Therapeutic Goods Administration (TGA) for non-serious and expected adverse events, ensuring patient consent prior to reporting:
 - via the online Adverse Event Reporting Portal .
 - in writing, using the AEFI reporting form . Post or email the form to the <u>Therapeutic Goods Administration (TGA)</u>.
 - Note that patients can self-report non-serious and expected adverse events directly using either method.

COVID-19 Vaccination Referrals and Advice

Last updated: 15 July 2021

- Vaccination referrals

- 1. To refer patients for vaccination, use the Vaccine Eligibility Checker to confirm eligibility and identify the closest vaccination location.
- 2. Refer patients aged > 60 years with indications for Pfizer vaccine to an INPUT HID vaccination hub by emailing HNELHD-COVIDClinicBookingChange@health.nsw.gov.au with the subject header "COMMUNITY GP - PATIENT BOOKING REFERRAL", and either:
 - Include indication for vaccination with Pfizer (Comirnaty) in preference to AstraZeneca (ChAdOx1-S) or
 - Attach a completed Recommendation to Receive the Pfizer (Comirnaty) COVID-19 Vaccine form @
- For Residential Aged Care Facilities (RACFs) seeking staff vaccination, advise that RACF Management need to email Elizabeth.Grist@health.nsw.gov.au (non-secure) requesting return contact regarding RACF staff vaccination. The COVID Vaccination Program Operational Manager will contact the RACF Manager to make arrangements based on location and numbers of staff.


