

Thrombosis and Thrombocytopenia with COVID-19 Vaccine - A Pragmatic Approach

PHN EDUCATION SESSION

This session will discuss the evolving local and international data on thrombosis and thrombocytopenia syndrome (TTS) in the setting of the COVID-19 vaccine.

Topics will cover diagnostic challenges, risk assessment and communication of the risk discussion. Early recognition, signs and approach to patients with pre-existing thrombosis will be discussed acknowledging that this is still a grey area.
