

A discussion of language and its impacts: The Communications Charter

The Primary Health Network (PHN) is a signatory to The Communications Charter – 'The Charter'. We have made a formal commitment to integrate its eight principles into our workplace, our practices and processes. This education session will cover the Charter's language guides, looking at how you can communicate about mental ill-health and suicide so you leave having a more informed perspective on everyday communications to reduce stigma and improve the wellbeing of individuals and communities across our region.

The education session will be presented by Ed Braodbent from Life in Mind, along with Daniel Reynolds and Francesca Groves from the PHN Commissioning Team. They will introduce you to the principles of the The Charter, followed by a discussion and overview of language guides and their impacts on their audiences.

We all have a role to play in reducing stigma around mental ill-health and suicide, while also promoting help-seeking behaviour.
