Aboriginal Health Immunisation Update

PHN EDUCATION SESSION

Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Australians over the age of 50 and those with a chronic condition are among the group of Australians most at risk of Coronavirus. This update will provide information on the COVID-19 vaccines currently being rolled out.

This session will focus on the effectiveness of the vaccines in halting the spread of the COVID-19 virus, and the importance of vaccine uptake across Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities. There have been changes to the immunisation schedule for pneumococcal and meningococcal disease over the past year which will also be reviewed.
