SPEAKER: DR SUJATA ALLAN (FRACGP, MBBS, DCH) is a GP currently working at Armajun Aboriginal Health Service in Armidale and as a lecturer at the School of Rural Medicine at the University of New England.



Sujata has spoken at community events and conferences around NSW and interstate about the impact of air pollution, fossil fuels and climate change on health as part of Doctors for the Environment Australia (DEA), and has organised several educational events for health professionals on climate change and health. DEA is a non-profit organisation of doctors and medical students, dedicated to raising awareness of the health impacts of environmental degradation and climate change, and advocating to promote public health.

SPEAKER: DR GERARD BROWNSTEIN is a GP and an owner of Benalla Church Street Practice (Vic). He has a special interest in obstetrics, anaesthetics and tropical medicine. He was a founder of Northeast Sustainability and Health Group, a group of representatives from local hospitals / health services and general practices who aim to promote and facilitate environmental sustainability.
