The Hunter New England and Central Coast Primary Health Network (HNECC PHN) has developed new resources for Commissioned Services who report into the PMHC-MDS.

The HNECC PHN is implementing changes to reporting that will reduce the burden of reporting while still maintaining rigorous performance management to monitor key performance indicators and outcomes measurements in contracts.

These documents outline specific requirements regarding the collection and delivery of data for the Primary Mental Health Care Minimum Data Set (PMHC-MDS).
