

Diabetes Alliance Case Conferencing Clinics 2022

IN YOUR PRACTICE

You are invited to take part in the Diabetes Alliance program for people with Type 2 diabetes. Our aim is to ensure all people with diabetes in our region have access to the best care available with their own general practitioner and practice nurse.

We bring the diabetes specialist team to you.

The program is conducted within GP surgeries. Diabetes specialist teams visit surgeries for full day clinics aiming to undertake ten (10) case conferences each day. On clinic days, the diabetes specialist team consult patients with their usual GP and Practice Nurse.

The **Diabetes Alliance program** comprises an initial case conference clinic (maximum of 10 patients per day), and a 6 month follow up clinic with the same patients providing:

- An Endocrinologist, a Diabetes Educator and a PHN staff member to work alongside you during clinic appointments with patients.
- Support and guidance with administrative and recruitment activities.
- Ongoing support to embed quality improvement activity following the clinic.

Note: General Practitioners involved are eligible to apply for 40 Category 1 points in the RACGP QI&CPD Program for the 2020-2022 Triennium and ACRRM rural association. Nurses are also eligible for CPD.
