She is an Endocrinology Staff Specialist at Gosford Hospital, where she is the medical clinical lead for the Central Coast Local Health District High Risk Foot Clinic. She is also involved in the osteoporosis re-fracture prevention and the endocrine high risk antenatal clinics.



Dr Yuen regularly lectures in diabetes to medical students from the Western Sydney Universities and University of Newcastle and registrars of the Royal Australian College of General Practitioners. She is also a supervisor to research students of all levels in research projects across various aspects of diabetes management. She is passionate about research, teaching and managing diabetes and metabolic diseases.

Dr Michelle Reiss - Michelle is a GP and Lifestyle Medicine Intensivist. She started her career doing acute medicine as a Hospitalist in Canada and worked in ED both in Canada and Australia.
