The NCCG will be delivering telehealth services across the HNECC PHN region for bereaved young people aged 3 to 17 years, who are struggling in their grief and requiring specialist counselling to support their challenges.

The session will outline the referral pathways, eligibility criteria, program information, activities and practical case studies of children and young people who may access the service.
