SPEAKERS: **Nick Fischer** - currently works as the Practice Specialist for the Northern Sydney and Central Coast region as part of the GambleAware program, a program that aims to assist those negatively impacted by problem gambling in NSW. Prior to that, Nick worked as a full-time gambling counselor for Wesley Mission and has been working in the addiction space for the past 6 years.

Chris Davidson - has a dual role at GambleAware; he is the Central Coast Community Linker, providing community awareness and education on gambling harm, and he also provides counseling to those affected by gambling harm on the Central Coast. Chris has 25 years of experience working in substance and gambling addiction treatment and currently provides group work sessions within three rehab centres for those with dual gambling/substance addictions on the Central Coast.
