Veterans Connect is a service that connects former Australian Defence Force (ADF) members and their families to the right health, wellbeing and community supports on the Central Coast. Veterans Connect can link veterans, their families and carers to a wide range of supports to assist with the timely receipt of appropriate healthcare.

The aim of the program is to improve the health literacy of clients, assisting them to overcome barriers in accessing healthcare.

The session will provide an overview of the service and how GPs, Allied Health and other primary care services can 'connect in' with Veterans Connect to support former ADF members and their families to access the correct health care services.
