The Hunter New England Central Coast Primary Health Network (HNECCPHN) offers GPs short term paid placements that provide an opportunity to update your knowledge and skills by working in a supported environment with local experts and their clinical teams.

ABORIGINAL HEALTH SCHOLARSHIP

- Working with Dr Elly Warren GP and colleagues at Yerin Eleanor Duncan Aboriginal Health Centre in Wyong.
- Placement to commence in May 2021.

ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

- Each Scholarship provides remuneration for the GP based on the HNECCPHN hourly rate and is paid when all scholarship requirements have been completed.
- Placements are for a total of 40 hours with some flexibility to be negotiated such as 4 hours a week over 10 weeks, 5 x 8-hour days or 40 hours in a 1-week block.
- GPs will contribute to patient care within the hospital and community settings including but not limited to ward rounds, clinics, outpatients, completing assessments and referrals.
- The Scholarships will improve networking between GPs, specialists and clinical teams.
- Each Scholarship will attract RACGP and ACCRM for 40 Category 1 CPD points.
- GPs will complete a placement workbook and a pre and post evaluation.

ABOUT THE ABORIGINAL HEALTH PLACEMENT

- GPs will attend a unique and comprehensive cultural awareness induction.
- GPs will work alongside Yerin GPs, programs teams and visiting specialists (Paediatrician, Endocrinologist, Psychiatrist and Addiction Specialist) to provide patient care and gain an understanding of the Closing the Gap initiative and the complexity of care needs of Aboriginal clients and their families on the Central Coast.
- Improved networking between GPs and Aboriginal Health Services on the Central Coast.
