The Hunter New England Central Coast Primary Health Network (HNECCPHN) has established a GP Scholarship offering Central Coast GPs short term paid placements within interesting clinical areas of the Central Coast Local Health District. These placements will offer GPs an opportunity to update their knowledge, skills and network by working in a supervised environment with local specialists and their clinical teams.

- Placement to commence in May 2021.

ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

- The Scholarship is available for GPs to experience placements in different clinical areas.
- Each Scholarship provides remuneration for the GP based on the HNECCPHN hourly rate and is paid when all scholarship requirements have been completed.
- Placements are for a total of 40 hours with some flexibility to be negotiated such as 4 hours a week over 10 weeks, 5 x 8-hour days or 40 hours in a 1-week block.
- GPs will contribute to patient care within the hospital and community settings including but not limited to ward rounds, clinics, outpatients, completing assessments and referrals.
- The Scholarships will improve networking between GPs, specialists, clinical teams and the CCLHD.
- Each Scholarship is pending points by the RACGP and ACCRM for 40 Category 1 CPD points.
- GPs will complete a pre and post evaluation and complete a placement workbook.
