CCLHD Menopause Service GP panel update

NSW Government funding

- NSW Government has committed \$40.3 million over 4 years(2022-2026) to establish 16 new services for women experiencing severe & complex symptoms of menopause.
- The services will build on NSW's successful <u>Osteoporotic Refracture Prevention</u> <u>services</u> to give women access to focused menopause care.
- Funding for a Menopause Service provided to all NSW LHD'S with an Osteoporosis Refracture Prevention Service

Proposed Hub & Spoke Model

Accessibility for women will be improved by -

- Establishment of 4 larger Menopause speciality hubs providing doctors, allied health & nursing staff.
- Establishment of 12 menopause services providing a co-ordinator, allied health & nursing staff.

CCLHD-Menopause Service

- CCLHD –Funded for a Menopause service non-medical model. Allocated funding for a co-ordinator, physiotherapist, psychologist, dietician, Aboriginal Health worker & administration.
- Funded from 1st July 2023
- Service planning & mapping commenced
- Stakeholder planning meetings commenced

RNS HUB

- RNS HUB- Funded as Medical model.
- RNS-Extra 1.2 FTE medical funding to enhance existing RNS Menopause Service.
- CCLHD Menopause service to refer patients to RNS HUB for Medical consultation either virtual or face to face as needed.

Menopause Service planning progress

- Planning in progress with ACI & stakeholders to develop optimal Menopause service under non-medical model
- HUB & Service process planning day March 30th with RNS/CCLHD/Far West LHD, West Sydney LHD
- Awaiting ACI to complete & deliver MOC for both Menopause service/HUB
- Plan to update Central Coast Health Pathways to include treatment management & referral process for severe & complex patients
- Plan to provide Menopause education to Primary care virtual & face to face sessions by staff specialists
