## Pulse Oximeter requests

- MS Form for requests
- General Practices who have agreed to support COVID positive patients.
- Practices can request up to 5 pulse oximeters for local distribution.
- If you elect to have it delivered to the patient, only 1 pulse oximeter will be dispatched to the patient.
- Answering the first question will take you to either the **practice delivery** ordering module or the **patient delivery** ordering module.

Please note: Pulse oximeters are a finite product and should only be provided -

- *when the GP deems it appropriate due to significant symptoms. (not the worried well)*
- *where knowing your patient has normal oxygen levels will prevent them being sent to hospital.*
