



We're online!



School Vaccination clinicians now use iPads to:

- retrieve student consents
- record vaccination details.

Added benefits of being online:

- access to student Air record during clinic
- vaccination records uploaded to AIR the day of clinic – real time accurate records!

Human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine



Changes under the National Immunisation Program in 2023



Australia HPV dosing schedule changes as of 6th February 2023



Single dose



Catch up extended up to and including 25 years of age



Anyone who receives a single dose before 26 years of age are now considered fully vaccinated – NO further doses needed.



Immunocompromised should still receive 3 doses of HPV vaccine




HPV Females





Historical HPV Vaccination Coverage, Female Students, Year 7, 2008-2023





Historical HPV Vaccination Coverage, Male Students, Year 7,






Meningococcal ACWY
