What is the project?

Sustainable Equitable Access to Reproductive CHoice- SEARCH

A pilot with Ministry of Health funding to establish a health service model that will build the capacity of local service providers in regional and rural areas to provide high quality clinical services that are financially sustainable - 2021-2024

- The aim is to address the lack of access to affordable and appropriate reproductive choiceAreas of reproductive health need-rural and remote
- Areas of high socio-economic disadvantage
- Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Women
- Providers partner with SEARCH via MOU





GUIDING PRINCIPLES

- No out-of-pocket cost services for people in need
- Abortion and LARC close-to-home and at a "one-stop" service
- Evidence-based and client-centred
- Trained and credentialled health professionals
- Ongoing support and Community of Practice
- Support to develop referral pathways
- Support in the development and implementation of clinical governance, risk management, communications, quality improvement strategies and financially sustainable models



What's involved in SEARCH Project?

Professional education:

- blended learning packages for pregnancy options, medical abortion up to 9 weeks, implant insertion/removal & IUD insertion/removal
- face-to-face workshops for implant and IUD
- supervised clinical placements for IUD
- mentorship program for medical abortion up to 9 weeks
- community of practice
- Institutional supports:
 - support to develop local clinical governance mechanisms, risk management strategy, policies, procedures, clinical documentation tools/forms, funding models and clientfacing resources based on FPNSW templates & local consultations
- Clinical services:
 - fly-in-fly-out (FIFO) service provision to supplement abortion & LARC services (in early stages of project)
- Evaluation:
 - support to develop data collection systems/methods
- Liaison:
 - with LHDs to develop referral pathways and options for complications, complicated cases and terminations over 9 weeks gestation
