

Advanced Life Support ALS2

This internationally accredited two day course is accredited by the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) and Resuscitation Council (UK).

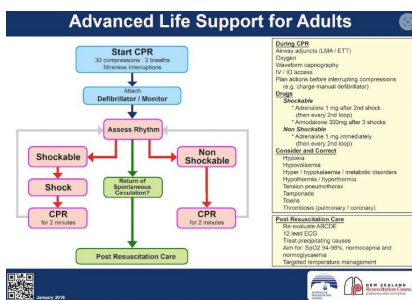
It is designed for health care professionals who would be expected to apply these skills as part of their clinical duties. Appropriate participants include doctors and nurses working within ED, CCU, ICU, OT and as part of critical care teams and paramedics.

Prior skills and CPR competence is an essential pre-requisite to attending this course.



ALS2 covers

- Recognition, assessment and management of the deteriorating patient using an ABCDE approach
- Management of cardiorespiratory arrest
- Management of life-threatening arrhythmias
- Planning immediate post resuscitation care
- Managing acutely deteriorating patients in special circumstances e.g. trauma arrest, asthma, pregnancy
- Team leader and followership skills
- Structure communication and handover
