ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

- The Scholarship is available for GPs to experience placements in different clinical areas.
- Each Scholarship provides remuneration for the GP based on the PHN hourly rate and is paid when all scholarship requirements have been completed.
- Placements are for a total of 40 hours with some flexibility to be negotiated such as 4 hours a week over 10 weeks; 8 hours a week over 5 weeks or 40 hours in a 1-week block.
- GPs will contribute to patient care within the hospital and community settings including but not limited to ward rounds, clinics, outpatients, completing assessments and referrals.
- The Scholarships provide networking opportunities building supportive relationships between generalists and specialists, strengthening the provision of general care in the community.
- Each Scholarship is accredited for 40 RACGP CPD hours, 5EA and 35RP.
- GPs will complete pre and post evaluation and course activities described in the scholarship workbook.
- GPs accepted to placements will be required to meet requirements for CCLHD recruitment activation as a Contingent Worker.

EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI) PROCESS

All applications received will be reviewed by the GP Scholarship Advisory Committee and notified by PHN. The process is competitive as we have limited places.
