### **Mental Health**

The "Indicated Mental Health with no diagnosis" Report, found in CAT4, will display the likelihood of a Mental Health condition based on a mental health medication or a mental health care plan being recorded in the patient record without a diagnosis. Any mental health diagnoses included in the existing CAT4 reports/filters is considered regardless of whether the diagnosis is marked as active or inactive in the patient record.

•Red = likely

•Orange = possible


The report displays

•Mental health medication, mental health MBS item numbers and the resulting likelihood

- •Chronic disease co-morbidities
- •Other Mental health risk factors.

The PHN has created a Model for Improvement that details how to increase the proportion of patients who have an accurate mental health diagnosis coded in their patient file.




### Mental Health Treatment Plan Review

The middle row outlines the number of patients that have been billed for a GP Mental Health Treatment Plan Review item number.

To identify patients eligible for a Mental Health Treatment Plan, please search for 'mental health treatment plan review' on the <u>PenCS website</u>.

The Medicare item descriptor notes that the treatment plan should be reviewed **at least once**.



**GP** Mental Health Treatment Medicare items include: MES items 2700, 2701, 2715 or 2717 - Preparation of a GP Mental Health Treatment Plan (effective from 1 November 2011); MBS item 2712 - Review of a GP Mental Health Treatment Plan; and MBS item 2713 - GP Mental Health Treatment Consultation. ### Mental Health Treatment Plan

The top row outlines the number of patients that have been billed for a GP Mental Health Treatment Plan item number.

To identify patients eligible for a Mental Health Treatment Plan, please search 'mental health treatment plan on the <u>PenCS</u> <u>website</u>.

#### **GP Mental Health Treatment Consultation**

The bottom row outlines the number of patients that have been billed for a GP Mental Health Treatment Consultation.

The GP Mental Health Treatment Consultation item is for an extended consultation with a patient where the primary treating problem is related to a mental disorder, including for a patient being managed under a GP Mental Health Treatment Plan. This item may be used for ongoing management of a patient with a mental disorder.

**Tip** - Comparing the no. of patients with a coded mental health condition and the number of Mental Health Treatment Plans billed is a quick way to see how many patients may be eligible for a treatment
