 A priority for the Australian Digital Health Agency from 2020- 2022 is enablement and adoption of My Health Record (MHR). In August 2020, nationally there are: 22.82 million total My Health Records with 2.24 billion documents uploaded. 94% of general practices registered with 84% using MHR to upload health summaries, event summaries and view hospital discharge summaries, medicines overview, pathology reports, diagnostic imaging reports and documents uploaded by other healthcare providers. 90% of Australians have a MHR. Consumers use MHR to upload health summaries, health notes, Advanced Care Directive Custodian Reports, immunisation and organ donation information and view pathology reports. 	 Enable person centred care by encouraging clinicians to proactively discuss digital health options and initiatives with their patients. Using the General Practice Team (administration, nurses, practice manager, GPs), develop and maintain an effective whole of practice approach to digital health. Have a team meeting to brainstorm how an integrated digital health approach can improve income generation and patient care. Complete an internal audit of the systems currently in use and their interoperability. Ensure whole practice team adhere to Australian privacy principles. Ensure whole practice team have knowledge of information security.
