

ARE YOU A GP WORKING IN REGIONAL/REMOTE AREAS OF NSW?

If yes, researchers at the Chris O'Brien Lifehouse are conducting a qualitative study to investigate survivorship needs for patients who have been diagnosed with head and neck cancer. To do this, we are seeking input from General Practitioners who have experience in caring for patients undergoing head and neck cancer management to understand the survivorship needs of patients in regional/rural areas of NSW. A GP currently practicing in regional or remote areas of New South Wales, who has been involved in the management of head and neck cancer survivors.
