The TOTAL FERTILITY RATE in 2013-15 was 2.1 BIRTHS PER WOMAN (NSW 1.9)

15.3% of mothers SMOKED IN PREGNANCY in 2014-16 which was SIGNIFICANTLY HIGHER than the **NSW AVERAGE**

> 6.9% of babies born in 2012-14 were **LOW BIRTH-WEIGHT (NSW 5.2%)**

A FIRST TRIMESTER ANTENATAL VISIT occurred in 82.8% of pregnancies in 2014-16 which was SIGNIFICANTLY HIGHER than the NSW AVERAGE

18% of the population are aged 0-14 years (NSW 18.5%)

22.9% of the population are aged 65 years + (NSW 16.3%)

MENTAL HEALTH

HIGH OR VERY HIGH PSYCHOLOGICAL

DISTRESS was experienced by 12.2 of every 100 adults in 2014-15 (NSW 11)

CHRONIC MENTAL AND BEHAVIOURAL PROBLEMS were experienced by 14.4 of every 100 people in 2011-12 (NSW 13.1)

There were 133 HOSPITALISATIONS for INTENTIONAL SELF-HARM in 2014-16 at a rate of 187.3 per 100,000 people which was SIGNIFICANTLY HIGHER than the NSW RATE

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
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CANCER INCIDENCE

POTENTIALLY PREVENTABLE HOSPITALISATIONS Between 2014 and 2016 there were 1,377.6 POTENTIALLY PREVENTABLE HOSPITALISATIONS EACH YEAR at a rate of 1,938.6 per 100,000 This was SIGNIFICANTLY LOWER THAN **THE NSW RATE** (2,104.2)



ACCESS TO SERVICES

In 2014 1,168 PEOPLE experienced a BARRIER TO HEALTH CARE ACCESS with COST BEING THE MAIN REASON at a rate of 2.4 per 100 people (NSW 2.5)





In 2016 80.2% OF HOUSES were able to ACCESS THE INTERNET (NSW 82.5%)

There are 23 GENERAL PRACTICES in the area and FOR EVERY FULL-TIME GP THERE ARE 1,026 PEOPLE



There is 1 PUBLIC HOSPITAL

10,490 patients presented to the Tomaree EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT in 2016-17, 7,309 were SEMI OR NON-URGENT PRESENTATIONS and could have been managed in general practice
