It is supported by the Area Eating Disorders Coordinator and an Administrative Assistant.

The Eating Disorders Outpatient Service

The Eating Disorders Outpatient Service (EDOS) provides specialised assessment, treatment and referral for people with an eating disorder who live on the Central Coast NSW, within the Central Coast Local Health District.

The Clinical Psychologist Role includes:

- *Providing clinical psychological services to people and their families referred to the Eating Disorders Outpatient Service (EDOS) with regards to the clients disordered eating symptoms and behaviours.
- *a pivotal role in guiding the direction of treatment for the clients
- * working alongside other staff in the Eating Disorder Outpatient Service (EDOS) to increase access to treatment for people on the Central Coast with an eating disorder.
- * providing individual assessment and treatment.
- * Delivering CBT-E or CBT-T for adults and to providing Family Based Therapy (FBT) for children and adolescents.

This is a Permanent part-time position.
