

Introducing Our Practice



The establishment of Rutherford Medical Centre began on 21 January 1974 when Dr Sanjoy Chatterjee and Dr Sambhu Mukherjee opened their practice in Brooks Street Telarah.

Approximately two years later they needed to expand the practice, land was purchased at Rutherford Shopping Centre and a new purpose built practice was built.

After many years of successful practice together, Dr Rajiv Ahuja joined the team in June 2006. Dr Nagy Ghandour joined the practice at the beginning of 2014.

After over 40 years practicing together, in October 2014, Dr Sanjoy Chatterjee and Dr Sambhu Mukherjee retired from General Practice.

Dr Rajiv Ahuja continued the practice as Director and Dr Srikanth Sakrepatna joined the team upon their retirement. Dr Chau Tran joined in February 2017.



Our practice achieved Accreditation against the RACGP 5th Standards of General Practice and RACGP 5th Standards of Infection Control for the seventh time in December 2018. Accreditation is valid until March 2022.

The practice is fully computerised using Medical Director 3 and PracSoft 3 clinical software with a comprehensive back up system and IT support available.

Transport

Airport

Newcastle Airport is located at Williamtown, approximately 40 minutes form Rutherford. It is a large airport with many flights arriving and departing daily by several major named and smaller airline carriers. There are several daily connections to Sydney, Brisbane, Gold Coast, Canberra and Melbourne.

Road

Rutherford is situated on the New England Highway. The New England Highway is connected to the MI Pacific Motorway to Sydney and Pacific Highway to Northern NSW.

Train

CityRail operates many trains daily from Telarah Station, within 1km of the Rutherford Medical Centre. The major connecting station is at Maitland, within 2km of Rutherford. Trains connect at least hourly to Newcastle, Sydney and beyond. Countrylink travels via Maitland whilst on it Australia wide voyages.

Bus

Hunter Valley Buses operate within the Maitland area with several bus stops around the Rutherford Shopping Centre, known as Hillview Street on routes. Long distance bus travel is also available departing from Maitland.

Cessnock/Pokolbin Wineries

The Hunter Valley is Australia's oldest and one of its most well known wine regions.

The region is the home of many big name wine makers including McGuigans, Tyrells, Petersen's Champagne and Tempus Two.



The Hunter Valley Gardens are renowned for its spectacular garden display, the biggest display in Australia, over 60 acres of waterfalls, trails, scene landscapes, themes and gardens, shopping village and picnic area.



The region has over 120 wineries, 60 restaurants, 160 accommodation venues and many activities including wine tours, wine tasting, cooking classes, hot air ballooning, skydiving, aqua golf, boutique shopping and helicopter joy flights.

The region houses many attractions; Hunter Valley Gardens, Greg Norman's Vintage Golf Course, Cypress Lakes Resort, Concerts at Hope Estate and Tempus Two, Day On The Green at Bimbagen Estate, Blue Tongue Brewery and Potters Brewery.







Port Stephens

Newcastle's working harbour is one of the busiest with a minimum of twenty ships waiting offshore at any one time.




The Newcastle Knights call Newcastle home. The Knights supporters are famous Australia wide for their patriotism.

Newcastle's beauty really is something not to be missed.




Rutherford Map
